## News from CDO

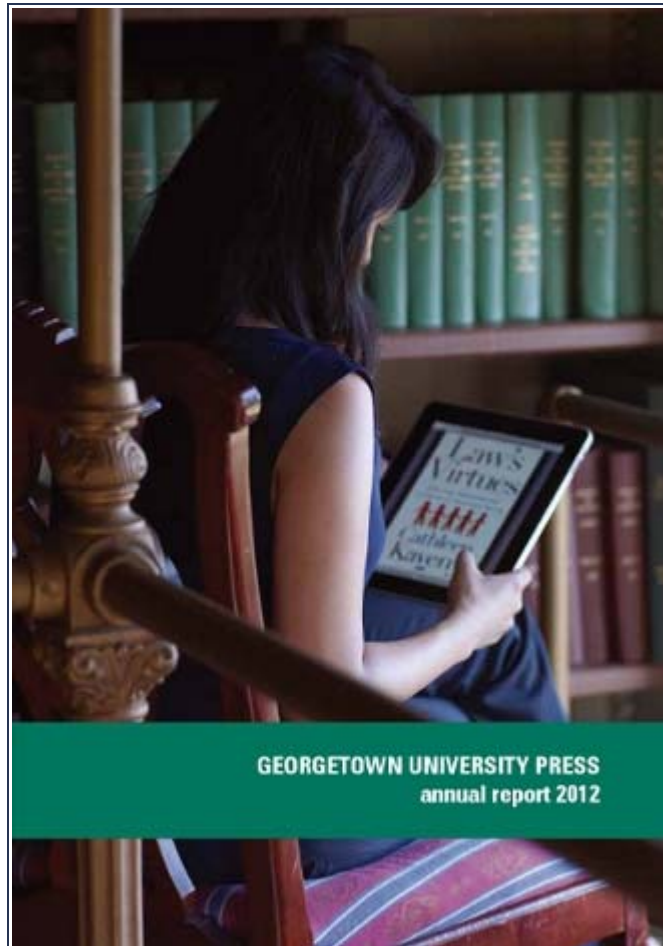
