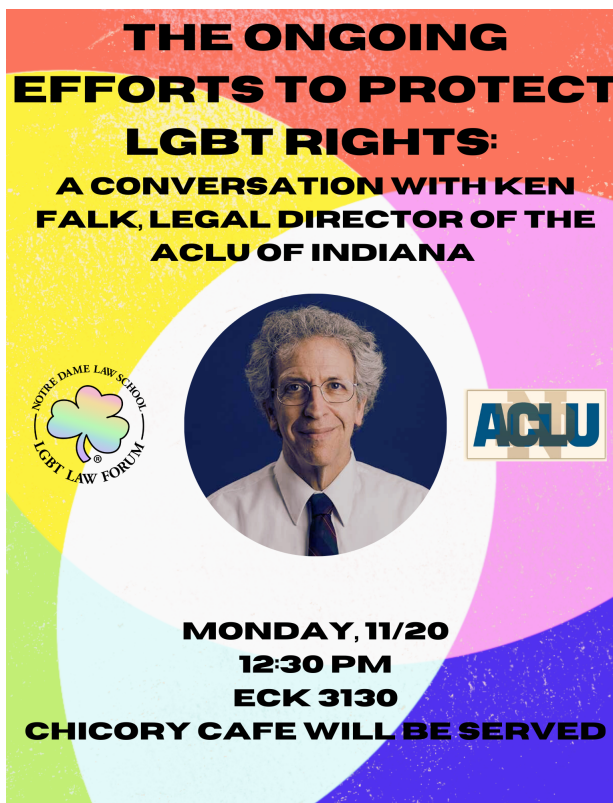

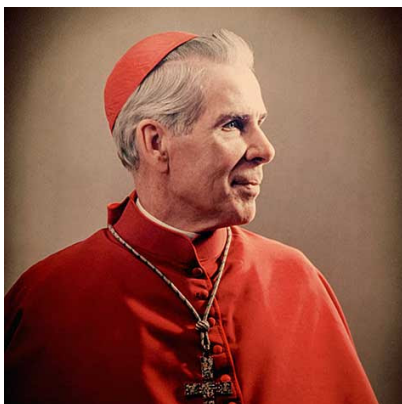

Saint of the Week: Venerable Fulton Sheen with Alexa Hassell



Born in 1895, Venerable Fulton Sheen was dedicated at Baptism to Our Lady. When he received First Communion, Sheen renewed his dedication to the Mother of God, one that remained with him throughout his entire life. Sheen taught philosophy and theology for a few years before starting his radio show, *The Catholic Hour*, in 1930. After being appointed Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of New York, Sheen moved to television with his show *Life is Worth Living* and later won an Emmy for "Most Outstanding Television Personality."

Sheen was also a prolific writer. During World War II, he penned a book on prayer. While written specially for soldiers, the text draws out beautiful reflections on Our

Lady, the Eucharist, and the soul.

Bishop Sheen Presents is a podcast which posts reflections from Sheen on a variety of theological and social topics. You can visit the tomb of Fulton Sheen in Peoria, IL at the Cathedral of St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception and read more about him [here](#).
