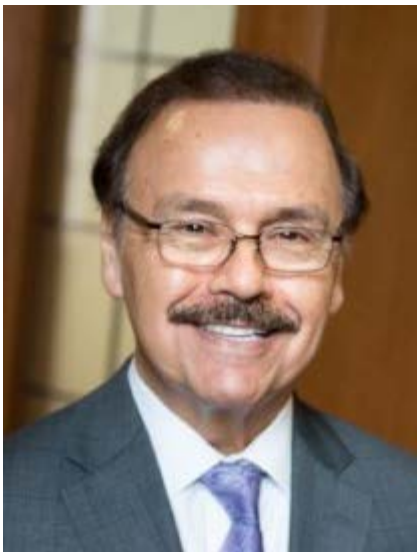
Alum James Sweeney confirmed as a judge

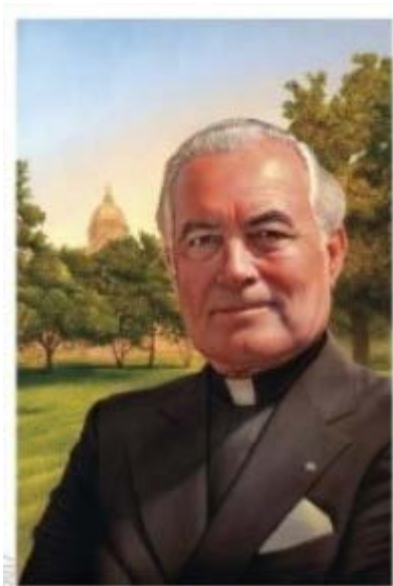

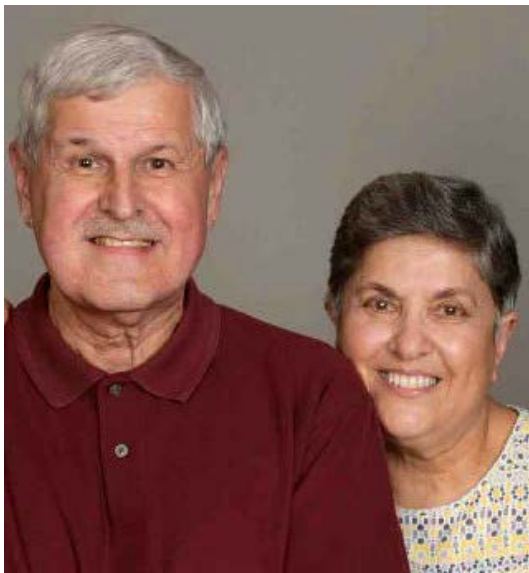
