Access to Eck and Biolchini

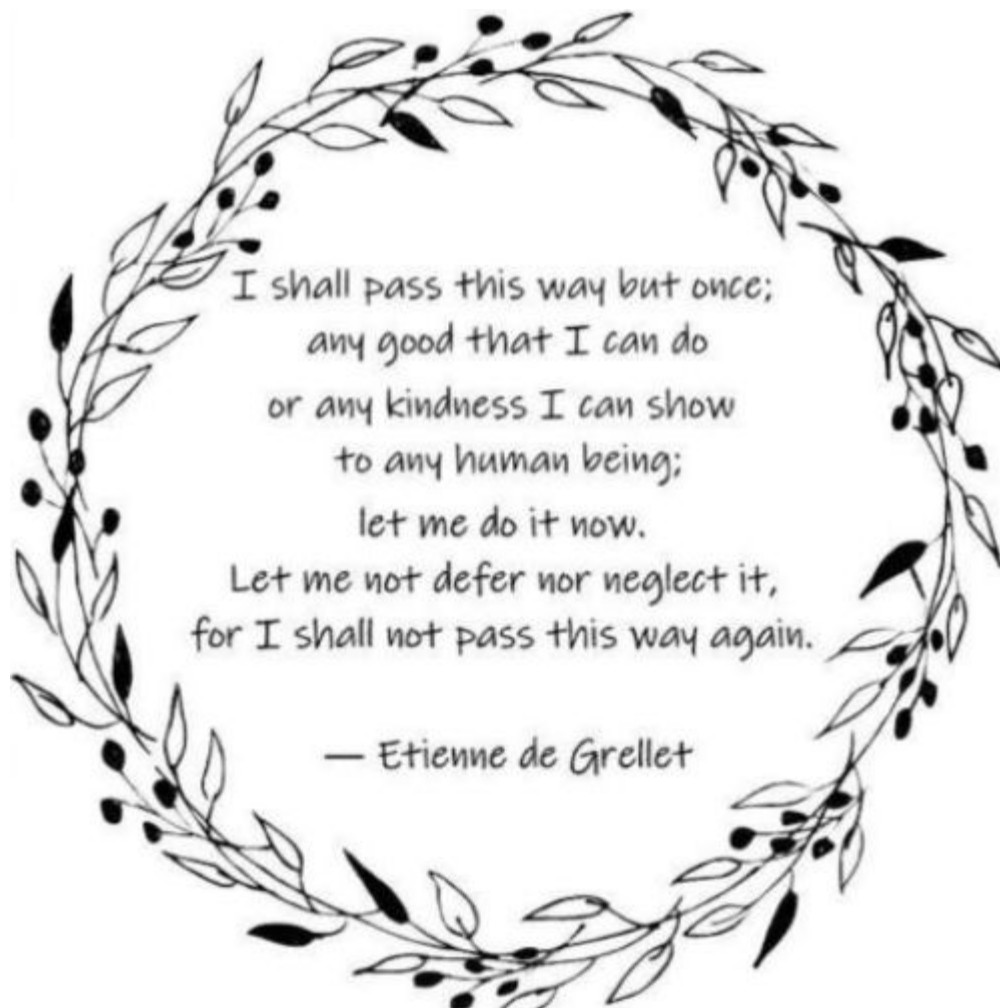
