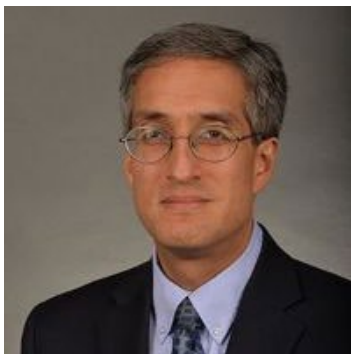
## The latest on the national injunction at the Supreme Court
