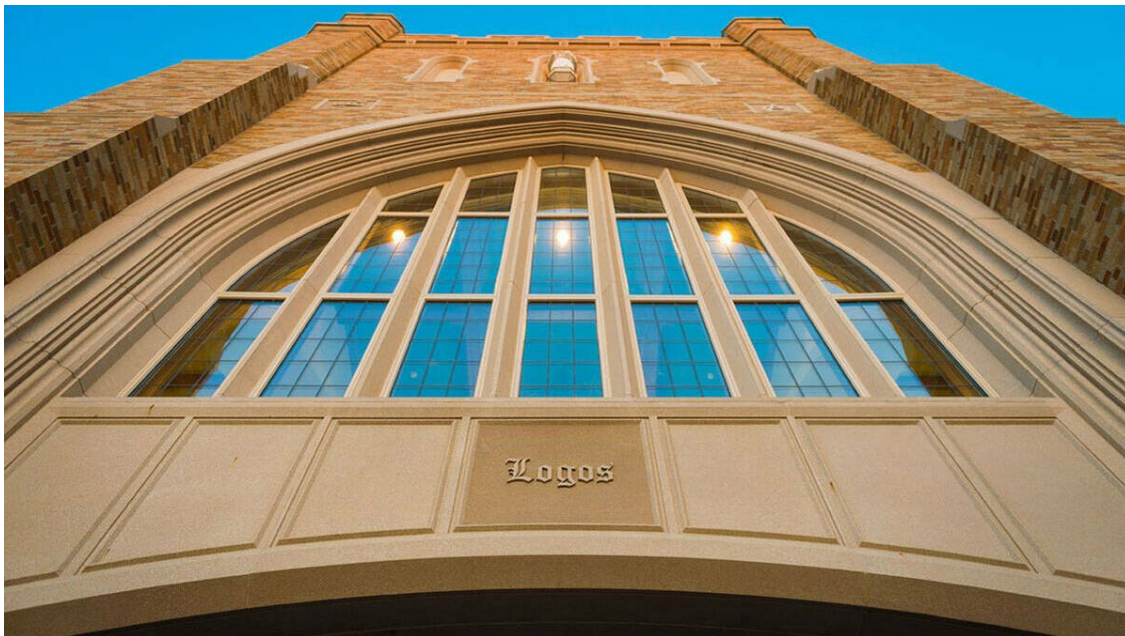

Professor Paolo Carozza testifies before

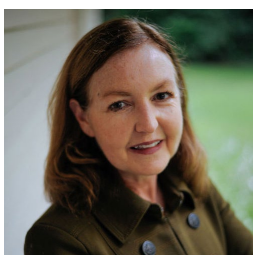
Inter-American Court of Human Rights

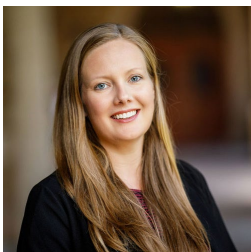

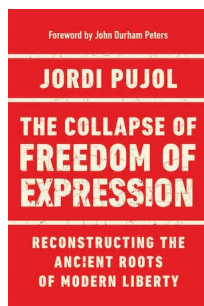
