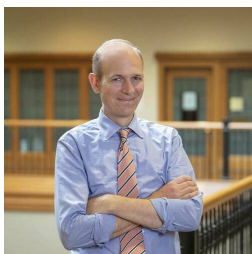


Steven Mitchell is scheduled to give a presentation for the LA Country Bar Association later this month titled "History and Language in Practice." More information is available [here](#).

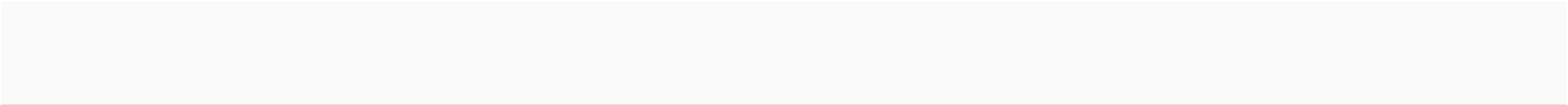
