Carter Snead was a featured speaker at the 2024 [Congreso Futuro conference](#) – a prominent annual science, technology, and innovation event in Latin America. Carter's presentation, "Remembering the Body: An Ethical Framework for the Regulation of Biotechnology," offered a new paradigm for thinking about self-governance rooted in reflection on how human embodiment relates to flourishing and what we owe to one another. Derek Muller has published a new paper, "Ideological Leanings in Likely Pro Bono Biglaw Amicus Briefs in the United States Supreme Court" in the Harvard Journal of Law and Public Policy.
